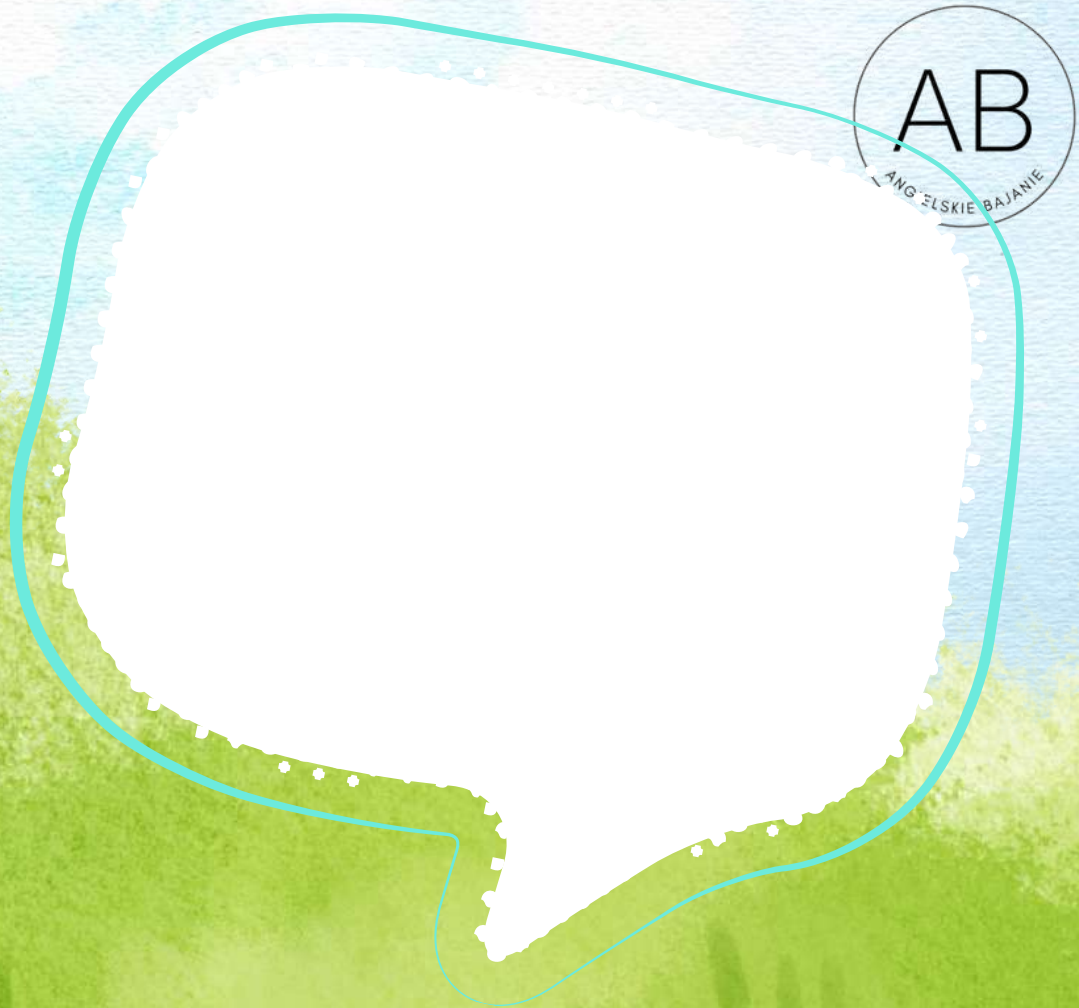

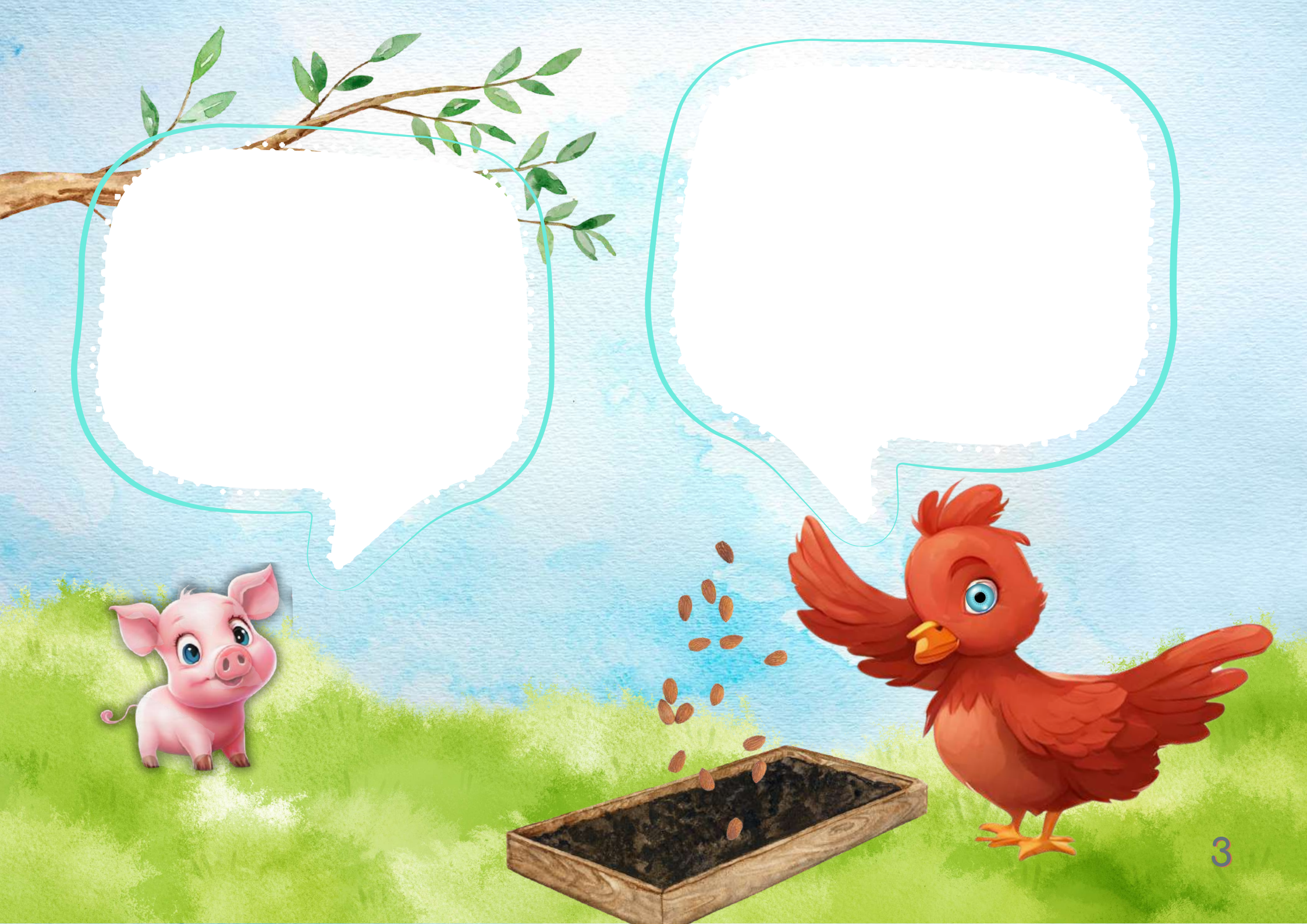

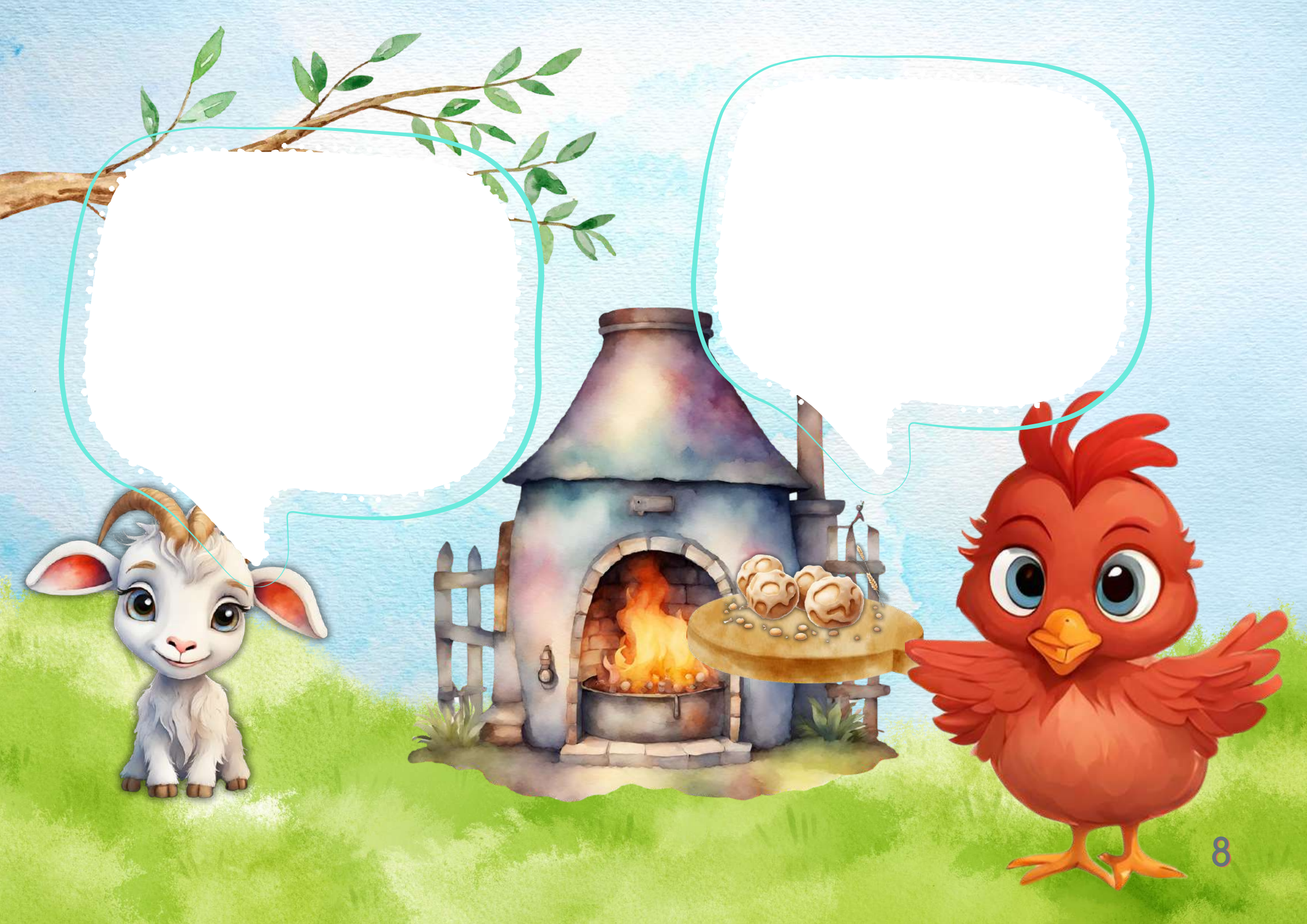
















Who can there be,
